Privacy Policy

Overview

The practices set forth in this Privacy Policy apply to the services available under the domain and sub domains of www.turboii.com, www.turboii.com. This Privacy Policy describes the information, as part of the normal operation of our services, we collect from you and what may happen to that information. Although this policy may seem long, we have prepared a detailed policy because we believe you should know as much as possible about TurboParts practices so that you can make informed decisions.

By accepting the Privacy Policy in registration, you expressly consent to our use and disclosure of your personal information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy is incorporated into and subject to the terms of TurboParts' End User License Agreement and other terms and conditions relative to the Site. This Privacy Policy is effective for all users.

- <u>Automatic Information:</u> We receive and store certain types of information whenever you interact with
 us, including via a Distributor or Distributor Site. For example, like many web sites, we use "cookies," and we
 obtain certain types of information when your web browser accesses and navigates the Site. You can set your
 web browser to alert you whenever you are about to receive a "cookie" and then you can choose not to
 accept it. If you do so, however, you may not be able to use the Product.
- <u>E mail Communications</u>: To help us make e mails more useful and interesting, we often receive a confirmation when you open e mail from the Site if your computer supports such capabilities. You may, however, choose to opt out of receiving promotional e-mail from TurboParts. In compliance with the 2003 Can SPAM Act, we offer the ability to opt-out of receiving communications from us at any time by sending us a message indicating your request to: tpsupport@dstinc.com, responding via a direct opt-out link on our e mail communications, or by writing to us at: 2 South Pointe Drive, Lake Forest, California 92630.
- <u>Information from Other Sources:</u> We might receive information about you from other sources (such as your WD) and add it to our account information.

We Automatically Collect:

Internet Protocol (IP) Address. We record your IP address each time you visit the Site. Recording IP addresses helps us determine usage and traffic patterns.

Sharing With Third Parties

TurboParts agrees that information collected by us relating to the identity, quantity, prices and dollar value of products ordered or purchased by you using the Product, or the identity of your customers, ("End User Data") will constitute your confidential proprietary information. We will not disclose the End User Data to others and will use reasonable efforts, consistent with those it uses in protecting its own confidential, proprietary information, to protect against improper disclosure of any End User Data. Notwithstanding the foregoing, we may use the End User Data internally. We may also perform analyses of the End User Data, only together with comparable information relating to the purchasing activity of other participants in the Product, and may provide to third parties the results of such analyses, or may make available to others aggregated data concerning the purchasing activities of all or a subset of the participants in the Product that include the End User Data; provided that such analyses or aggregated data do not contain identifying information that would enable the recipient to determine your identity of the identity of your customers.

We do not and will not disclose your identity in any statistical reports or analyses distributed to third parties. Subject to the foregoing, you agree that we are permitted to generate, publish, distribute, make use of, disseminate and sell statistical information with regard to the Trading Partners, transactions, activities and other information derived from the Product (including, without limitation, registration and Product participation activities) and provide reports of aggregated anonymous data.

Business Transfers

As we continue to develop our business, we might form, sell or buy subsidiaries or business units. In such transactions, customer information generally is one of the transferred business assets but remains subject to the promises made in any pre-existing Privacy Policy (unless, of course, the customer consents otherwise). Also, in the unlikely event that TurboParts sells the Product or substantially all of its assets or stock, customer information will of course be one of the transferred assets.

Legal Requests

We release account and other personal information when we believe such release is appropriate to comply with the law or enforce or apply our End User License Agreement and other terms and conditions or protect the rights, property, or safety of the Site, the Product, our users, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for fraud protection and credit risk reduction. Due to the existing regulatory environment, we cannot ensure that all of your private communications and other personal information will never be disclosed in ways not otherwise described in this Privacy Policy. Obviously, however, this does not include selling, renting, sharing, or otherwise disclosing personally identifiable information from customers for commercial purposes in violation of the commitments set forth in this Privacy Policy.

What About Cookies?

Cookies are alphanumeric identifiers that we transfer to your computer's hard drive through your web browser to enable our systems to recognize your browser and to provide features. The Site uses persistent cookies to identify members after their first visit. These cookies remain on the hard drive of a personal computer and may allow a member to enter the site without having to log in on every visit. To access any secure areas such as your account information, you must still enter your password. You can choose to disable cookies by deselecting that option under your browser preferences. When you disable cookies, you can browse the Site, but you cannot access your membership information or make purchases. Disabling cookies can also interrupt audio, video and accept the Site's persistent cookie.

Usage Tracking

The Site's database tracks the traffic throughout our site. This information is used to compile overall statistics and is not recorded at an individual level. The statistics help us decide which products and services best serve our members and guests.

How Secure Is Information About Me?

It is important for you to protect against unauthorized access to your password and to your computer. Be sure to sign off or close your browser window when finished using a shared computer. You are responsible for all actions taken with your credential and password, including fees charged to your account. Therefore we do not recommend that you disclose your Site password to any third parties. If you choose to share your credential and password or your personal information with third parties, you are responsible for all actions taken with your account and therefore you should review that third party's privacy policy. If you lose control of your password, you may lose substantial control over your personal information and may be subject to legally binding actions taken on your behalf. Therefore, if your password has been compromised for any reason, you should immediately change your password.

Which Information Can I Access?

The Site gives you access to a broad range of information about your account and your interactions with TurboParts for the limited purpose of viewing and, in certain cases, updating that information. You cannot access the information of other users of the Site.

What Choices Do I Have?

As discussed above, you can always choose not to provide information, even though it might be needed to make a purchase or to take advantage of certain features of the Site or the Product.
